Recycle It

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RCYCLe It

Provide students with a "Recycle It" game board and place them into pairs. Give each pair one deck of cards (remove all of the 10s and face cards) and make a rule about the number your students are trying to build (greatest or least).

When playing with the hundreds version, students take turns drawing four cards (one at a time) and placing them in the card boxes on their game boards. As they draw, they can place the card in any given box, but once it has been put down, it cannot be moved.

To keep things interesting, one card can be "recycled" or thrown out of play. Students place this card face down in the "recycle bin" on their game board. Work is then transferred to the corresponding worksheet.

NOTE: Two versions of this activity are included. If you are playing with the easier board (tens vs. hundreds), students simply draw three cards instead of four. Also, if you are in kinder, you may want to remove additional cards to help keep the numbers smaller.


